Committee Responsibilities, Eligibility, Term and Compensation

Economic Development Advisory Committee

Responsibilities:

- The Committee shall act in an advisory capacity to the Board of Trustees as requested by the Board of Trustees and Town Manager.
- The Committee is authorized to explore matters related to economic development in Fraser and make recommendations to the Board of Trustees and Town Manager.
- The Committee shall hold at least one (1) regular meeting each quarter. A quorum is not required to hold a meeting. No vote or recommendation to the Town Board shall take place without a quorum.

Eligibility:

- All members of the Committee shall be bona fide residents of the Town, or own property within the Town, or have at least ten percent (10%) ownership interest in a business that owns property within the Town, or hold a management position with a business located in Fraser. Committee members should provide a broad representation from the community and have an interest in promoting the best interests of the Town and the surrounding community; be objective and thoughtful.
- Committee members shall have expertise or experience in one (1) or more of the following or related areas:
 - Legal, sales, marketing, finance and capital fundraising.
 - Strategic planning, community development and engineering.
 - Entrepreneurial, business development and job creation.
 - Telecommunications/internet, resort/tourism, retail, service/transportation, lodging/hospitality, energy/utilities, or commercial/office real estate.
