Dollar amount requested:

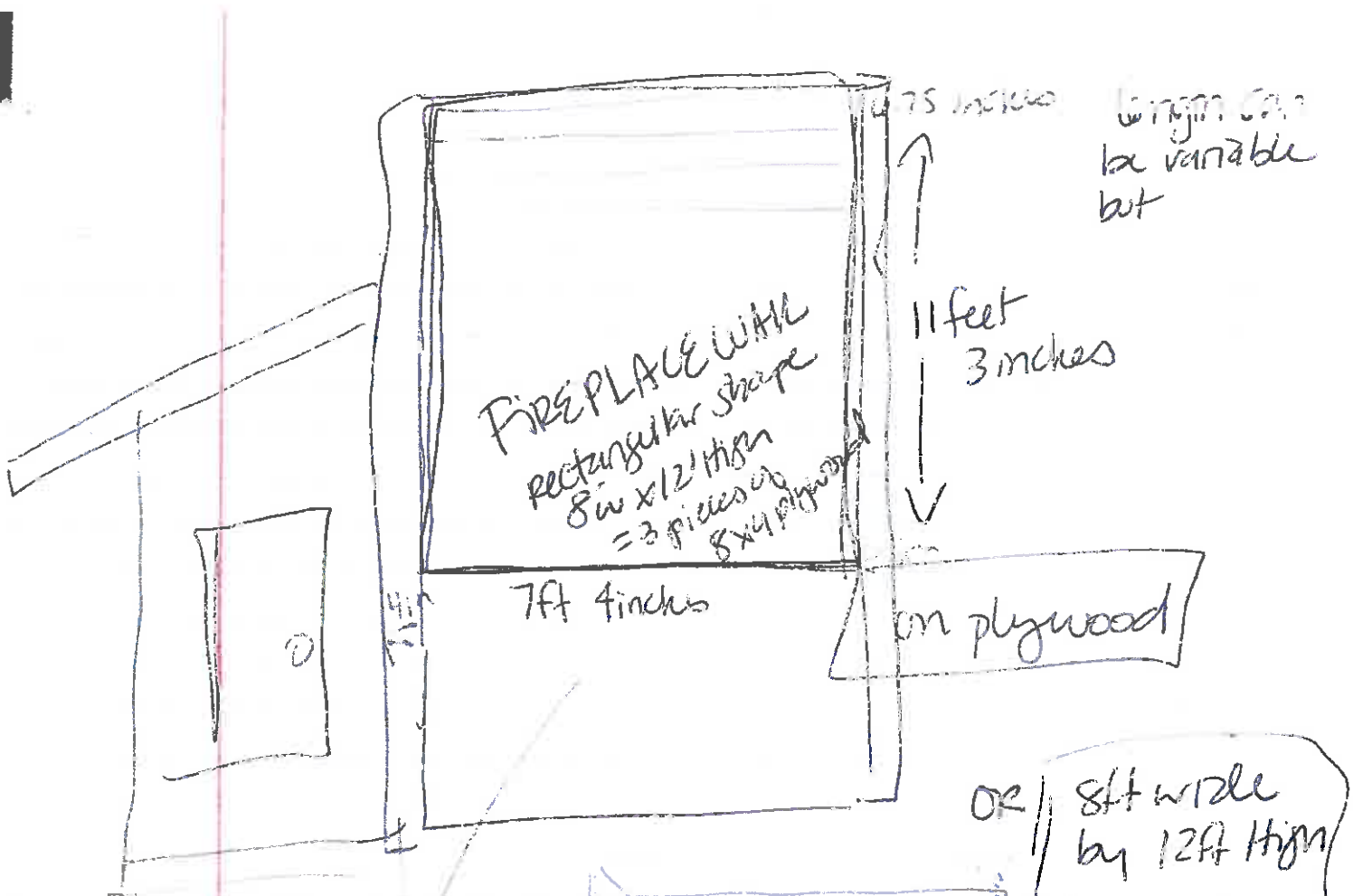
TBD, we are thinking between \$2000 - \$4000 but would need to secure proposal from artist first. Project approx 100 sq foot.

Match amount and description:

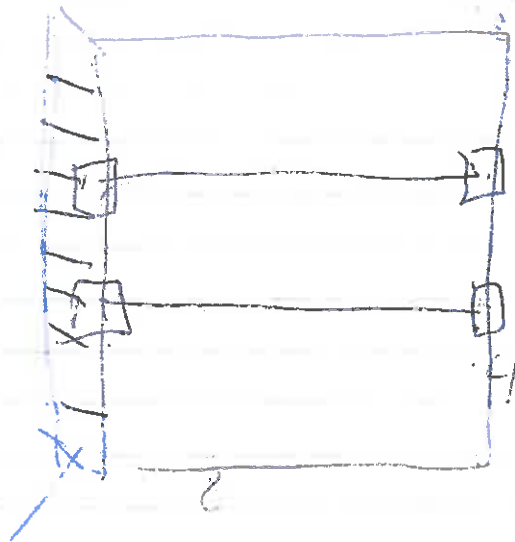

*The benefits of doing project on plywood is that artist can do the mural in their own workspace, regardless of weather, then mural will be assembled at location when complete.

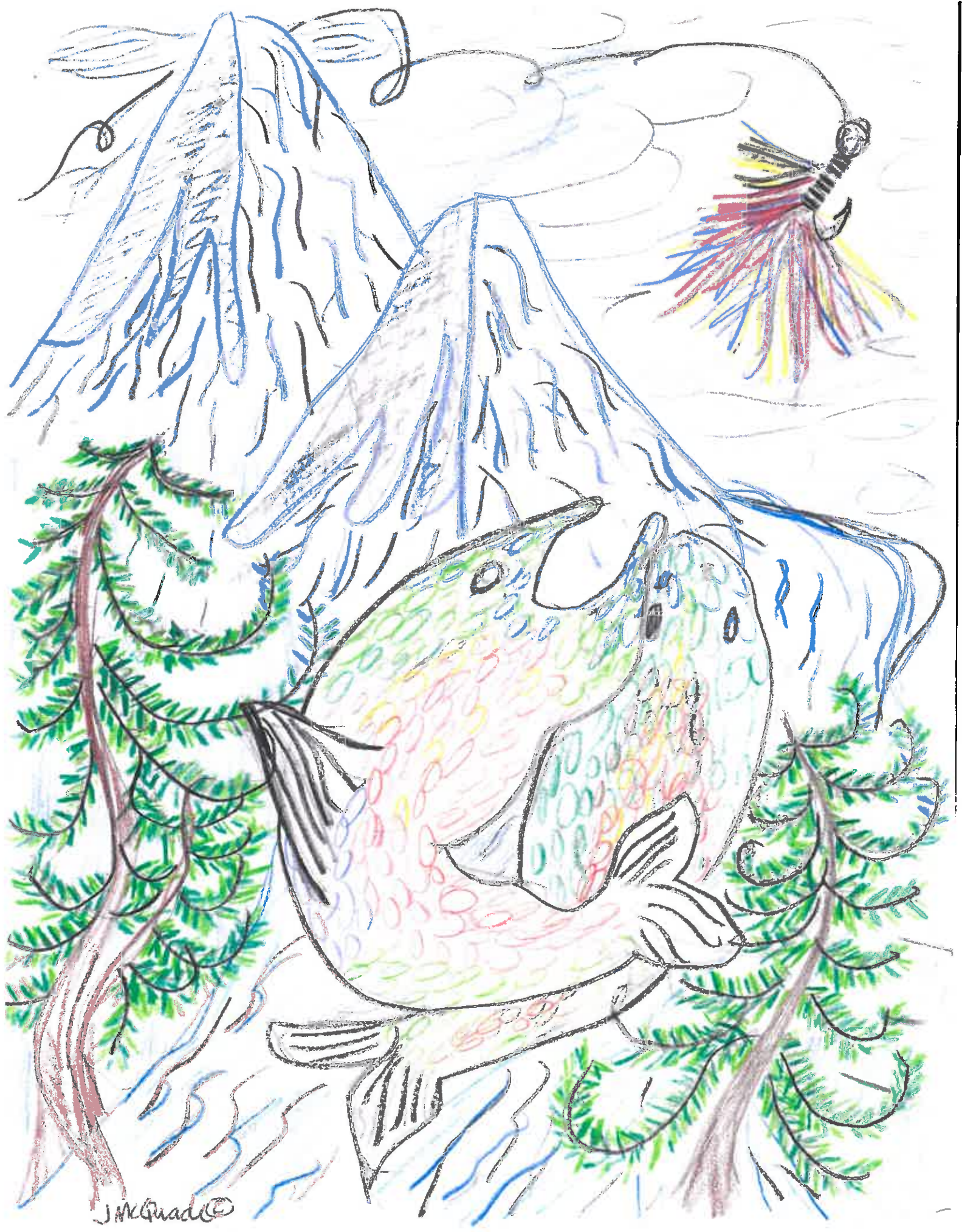


OR 8ft wide
